Explain to children that when people die their souls go to God in heaven but their bodies stay in the earth. But with Mary, God took her body and soul to heaven because he loved her so much. This is why Mary's Assumption is so special and this has only happened to Mary.

Read the slide title and look at the picture of Mary's friends. Can you tell how they are feeling? What do you think they are saying? Read through the flip cards and when completed invite children to ask a question about what happened when Mary died.

Slide 9 We celebrate the Feast of Mary's Assumption on August 15 Check out the date of the Feast of the Assumption on your class calendar. Children find each word in the sentence below on the matrix and highlight it in the sentence **and** in the Word Find. Check it out on screen.

The feast of the Assumption is the national feast day of Aotearoa New Zealand. Mary loves and cares for our people and protects our country and
