Read through the Learning Intentions with the class and identify some ideas/questions that might be explored in the lesson.

Slide 3 All over the world Catholics gather on Christmas Day to celebrate the Christ Mass

Read the statements and choose the correct floater to complete each one. Answers 1) D, 2) F, 3) C, 4) E, 5) A, 6) B

Slide 4 The first reading at the Christ Mass is Isaiah's description of Jesus Read the reading together — explain it is a very important piece of Scripture. How did the coming of God's son into the world change human history? How does having a relationship with God influence your life?

Slide 5 The Gospel at the Christ Mass is Luke's story of Jesus' birth

Read the Christmas story slowly and remind children to be alert to something they haven't heard before. Share these after the reading.

Use the flip book pages to help children think more deeply into the story. Work through each page using the questions to extend children's thinking.

Slide 6 The custom of telling the Christmas story in your school

Look closely at the image and invite children to make comments. Children share responses to the items on the pop up.

Sing using the MP3 'Jesus Christ is born'

Slide 7 Check Up

This formative assessment strategy will help teachers to identify how well children have achieved the Learning Intentions of the lesson.

Slide 8 Time for Reflection

The MP3 is played to help create a reflective atmosphere and bring the children to stillness and silence as the teacher invites them to reflect on the privilege they have to be able to share their knowledge and faith in God and celebrate the true meaning and impact of the birth of Jesus in the world.
