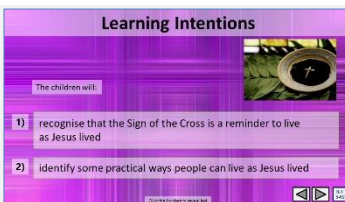

Slide 1 In Lent people try to follow Jesus more closely

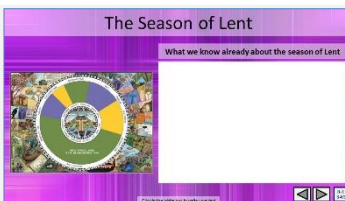
Use this slide as a focussing strategy to introduce the resource topic. Read the title together and invite children to share something they know about what it means to follow Jesus in Lent.

Slide 2 Learning Intentions

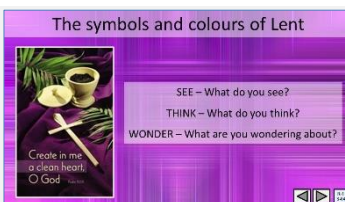
Read through the Learning Intentions with the class and identify some ideas/questions that might be explored in the resource.

Slide 3 The Season of Lent

Teacher records children's ideas about Lent.
Adapt Teaching and Learning Experience 1.

Slide 4 The symbols and colours of Lent

Children name what they can **see** on the prayer table.
Share what they **think** about it.
Make 'I **wonder**' statements.

Slide 5 The Ashes are made from the Palms left over from last Palm Sunday
 Adapt Teaching and Learning Experience 2
 Read each flip card and then let children explain to a partner how the ashes are made.

Slide 6 Saying sorry to people and saying sorry to Jesus
 Talk about the Season of Lent as a special time in the year to think about what we do and how sometimes we don't act in loving ways. When we have hurt someone we need to say we are sorry and Lent is a good time to learn about doing this.

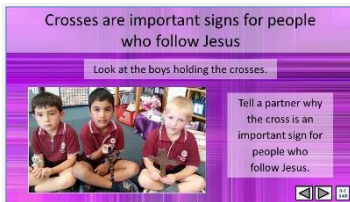
Explain when we hurt people we hurt Jesus too so we need to say sorry to him too. Use the slide to help the children understand this and complete the worksheet to consolidate the ideas.

Slide 7 The Cross is a sign the friends and followers of Jesus wear
 Adapt Teaching and Learning Experience 4
 You could have some crosses that children could wear and record in the word balloon how they feel wearing them.



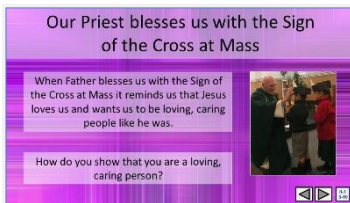
Teacher's Notes

Slide 8 Crosses are important signs for people who follow Jesus
 You could record what the children say and share this at assembly. You could add their comments from the previous and the next slide.



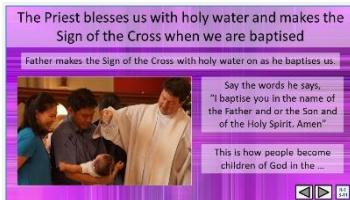
Teacher's Notes

Slide 9 When we make the Sign of the Cross we show we want to live like Jesus
 Children share how they show they are a follower of Jesus – this could also be recorded.



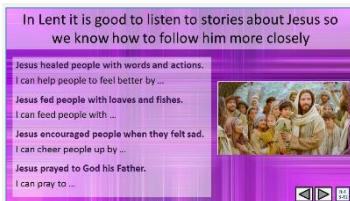
Slide 10 Our Priest blesses us with the Sign of the Cross at Mass
 Encourage children to share how it feels when you are blessed with the Sign of the Cross.

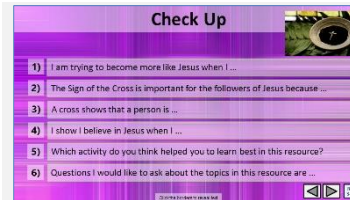
Slide 11 The Priest blesses us with holy water and makes the Sign of the Cross when we are baptised
 Invite children to say what is happening in the image.
 Explain that all children are born children of God but when you are baptised you become part of God's children in the family of the Church.

Slide 12 In Lent it is good to listen to stories about Jesus so we know how to follow him more closely
 Work through each item with the children and listen to their responses.
 Print off copies of the Children's Activity page 26 in the Teacher's Book or on the Resource Home page and add to children's RE Learning Journals.

Slide 13 Check Up
 This formative assessment strategy will help teachers to identify how well children have achieved the Learning Intentions of the resource.
 Teachers can choose how they use the slide in their range of assessment options.
 A worksheet of this slide is available for children in Years 5-8 to complete.

The last two items are feed forward for the teacher.
 Recording the children's responses to these items is recommended as it will enable teachers to adjust their learning strategies for future resources and target the areas that need further attention.

Slide 14 Time for Reflection

The MP3 is played to help create a reflective atmosphere and bring the children to stillness and silence as the teacher invites them to *remember what Jesus did when he lived on earth and how he showed his love for people. Think about how you show your love to people at home and at school. Ask Jesus to help you grow closer to him.*
