Slide 1 Pentecost then – Pentecost Today

Use this slide as a focussing strategy to introduce the resource topic. Read the title together and invite children to share something they know about the Feast of Pentecost.


Read the Bible stories about Pentecost during class prayer this week.

Slide 3 Make a mind map about the First Pentecost

Adapt Teaching and Learning Experience 1. Print a mind map for each child. Children complete their mind map and share it. If they cannot fill all the spaces they can add to it after the clip on the next slide. They could make notes of the new things they learned as they watch the clip and add them in.

Slide 4 Pentecost in the Liturgical Year

before Pentecost.

Pentecost comes between Easter and Ordinary Time.

Slide 6 The room that is the site where it is believed several significant events in Jesus' life took place

Introduce the idea that many of the places that are connected with Jesus' life and ministry that are noted in Scripture are now what is known as 'sacred sites'. Many of them have shrines or chapels built on them to mark the place because they are 'thought to be place". These places are visited by pilgrims

who come to remember Jesus, to walk in his footsteps and to pray as they recall his life. Children may like to research some of these places and share their findings.

Invite the children to brainstorm the names of all the people who demonstrate by their words and actions that the Holy Spirit is working in them as they respond to the ways God calls them to become holy like God.



Slide 10 Check Up

This formative assessment strategy will help teachers to identify how well children have achieved the Learning Intentions of the resource.
